“Gospel” - _____!

“Once you were dead because of your disobedience and your many sins. You used to live in sin, just like the rest of the world, obeying the devil—the commander of the powers in the unseen world. He is the spirit at work in the hearts of those who refuse to obey God. All of us used to live that way, following the passionate desires and inclinations of our sinful nature. By our very nature we were subject to God’s anger, just like everyone else. But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God’s grace that you have been saved!) For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus”- Ephesians 2:1-6

The Gospel means we have Victory

1. Victory over the Last Enemy, _____

And the last enemy to be destroyed is death—1 Corinthians 15:26

O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?”⁵⁶ For sin is the sting that results in death, and the law gives sin its power. ⁵⁷ But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ. – 1 Corinthians 15:55-57

2. Victory over the Second Enemy, _____

*But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
– 1 John 1:7*

*“Once again you will have compassion on us. You will trample our sins under your feet and throw them into the depths of the ocean!”
- Micah 7:19*

For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace. Thank God! Once you were slaves of sin, but now you wholeheartedly obey this teaching we have given you. ¹⁸ Now you are free from your slavery to sin, and you have become slaves to righteous living. Romans 6:14,17,18

3. Victory over the Third Enemy, _____

Memory verse: *So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. - Romans 8:1*

Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and has faith in him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life. - John 5:24

(Good News, Death, Sin, Judgement)
